WHERE: The course is 25 miles around the island of Oahu, from *Kailua Beach Park*, to *Makapuu*, around *Diamond Head Buoy* with the finish at the *Outrigger Canoe Club*.

Final crew lists and escort boat waiver to be turned in.
Entries received after 12:00pm on Saturday August 22nd^d will be charged \$290.00 per crew (no guarantee of receiving crew pareo).

Late Registration: ENTRY FEE - \$290 Sunday, August 23rd, from 6:30-7:00am.

CANCELLATIONS: Must be made before 12:00pm on Saturday, *August 22nd*
A \$30.00 fee will be charged for any cancellations after.

KEEP OUR BEACH PARKS CLEAN: Your club is responsible for removing all tires and rubbish from rigging site or you will be faced a fine

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- OHCRA rules will apply. You must be a member in good standing of HCRA.
- Liability waiver must be signed.
- Each crew must have their own escort boat. (Minimum length 18')
- Escort boats must have a radio that complies with OHCRA long distance rules.
- Canoes must have a canvas racing cover.
- Canoes and Escort boats must have their racing number displayed
- Crews affiliated with an out-of-state club are subject to approval.

- Open and Masters 40+ crews must consist of ten (10) paddlers.
- Youth and Masters 50+ crews may have up to 12 paddlers.
- Youth coaches contact Race Director (808-389-6377) the night before event to confirm if Youth division will be permitted to race.
- *Reminder - Canoe Clubs will not be allowed to load canoes at Kaimana Beach.* There is no permit to allow canoe trailers to park at Kaimana.

COURSE: - 8:30 Start

1. There will be two heats. Clubs will be assigned to a heat based on finish from previous years. Second heat will start 5 minutes later.
 2. Canoes line up Kaneohe side of Kailua Canal.
 3. Canoes face Lanikai, form a straight line between the beach and official boat. Second heat; line up 200 yards behind the first heat.
 - 4/ Any crew over the line (ahead of Outrigger), 10 minutes will be added to their overall time
 4. Start: The official boat will raise the Yellow flag – race will start within 1 minute. Yellow Flag will wave- to be ready. Red- Get Set. Green- Go!
 5. First change will be after Smiths Point.
 6. **Paddle around Diamond Head Buoy.**
 7. Finish by paddling around a yellow buoy at the Outrigger Canoe Club Channel and finish between two triangle buoys inside the channel at OCC.
- * In case of big surf, finish will be modified and crews/coaches will be notified at the coaches meeting on race day.

AWARDS:

- Individual medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each division.
- Perpetual trophy for Open division and first to finish.
- Perpetual trophy for first in Koa division.
- Pareo for each crew member (Guaranteed only with pre-registration).

LUNCH:

- Provided for **each crew member and a coach** at *Outrigger Canoe Club* from 1-3 pm.
- Cash bar available for purchase of beer and soda.

Outrigger Canoe Club

August 23, 2009

Race Course

1. Start: 8:30 am (Heat 1) and 8:35am (Heat 2)
2. Clubs will be assigned heats based on finish in previous years (fastest in first heat)
3. Canoes line up on Kaneohe side of Kailua canal facing Lanikai forming a straight line between the beach and official boat.
4. Second Heat line up 200 yards behind the first heat.
5. Any canoe over the line (in front of any Outrigger crew) will be assessed and a 10 minute penalty which will be added to their overall time.
6. Start: the official boat will raise the yellow flag. Yellow Flag – race will start in 1 minute.
Yellow Flag will wave – be ready. Red – Get Set. Green – GO!
7. First change: after Smith Point.
8. Paddle around Diamond Head (non-ama side) Buoy.
9. Finish by paddling around yellow buoy (non-ama side) at the Outrigger Canoe Club Channel, keep windsock to your right, and finish between two orange triangle buoys inside the channel at OCC.

Important Information

- * In case of big surf, the finish will be modified and crews/coaches will be notified at the coaches meeting.
- * All escort boats must be 18 feet or longer with VHF communication to avoid crew disqualification.
- * Escort boats must receive permission from the OHCRA official boat prior to entering channel for beach drop off.
- * Your club is responsible for removing all tires and rubbish from the race site. **Do Not leave your tires behind** or you will be faced with a fine. Please leave the beach clean!
- * All escort boats must go around Flat Island and Lanikai Reef to Smith Point, not through the race course.
 - Escort Boats need to radio check with the official boat at the following channel: VHS 72
 - Escort Boat waivers must be turned into the officials and final team roster

Reminders

1. Complimentary lunch is served between 1-3pm for each paddler and 1 coach by ticket only at OCC.
2. A script bar for beer and soda will be available after the race.
3. If supplies allow, additional pareos will be on sale for \$20.00 each at OCC after the race.

Keep our beach and beach park clean- your club is responsible to clean up your rubbish and remove any tires from the site or you will be fined.
